The show is scheduled to run from May 5th through June 11th, 2023 at the Loveland Museum in downtown Loveland, Colorado. The Call for Entry will open on August 10th and close on November 30th.

The Governor's Art Show and Sale is the largest fundraising effort of the Loveland Rotary Club and the Thompson Valley Rotary Club. JURY

This show is selected by a blind jury of 5. The show organizers will select 56 of the top scoring Colorado artists.

RULES FOR SUBMISSION

- All artists must reside in the State of Colorado and be 18 years of age or older.
- There is a non-refundable \$30 submission fee.
- All entries will be processed through www.GovernorsArtShow.org Make sure all entry information is correct; NO changes can be made, including title and price, after submission.

NOTE: Work submitted for the jury process should be representative of your work. If accepted, you are entitled to bring new work.

DIGITAL ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

Each applicant must submit 3 images. Please NO split screen images. We are a non-profit

organization and do not have tech support.

MEDIA CATEGORIES

Acrylic, Drawing, Egg Tempera, Mixed-Media, Oil, Pastel, Scratchboard, Watercolor and Sculpture. (No digital medium or prints allowed).

SALES AND RULES OF ACCEPTANCE

If accepted, all artwork must be original and for sale (no prints). All artwork must have been completed within the last three years. Accepted artwork may not have been exhibited in any previous Governor's Art Show. The Governor's Art Show will act as a gallery and retain 40% of the sale price on two dimensional artwork and 33.3% for three dimensional sculpture. If a sale is made after the closing of the show of a piece that was seen during the show, we hope that you will extend us the courtesy of sending us the appropriate commission.

All correspondence from the Governor's Art Show will be done via e-mail and your selection into the show will be sent in this manner.

All Artists are required to attend the Opening Night Gala, FRIDAY, May 5, 2023.
